Mentor Mentee

- Previously, our college had implemented class teacher concept for student mentoring.

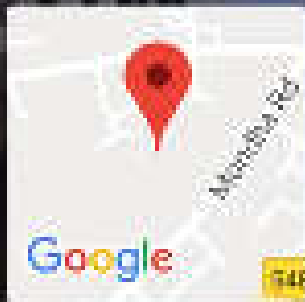
